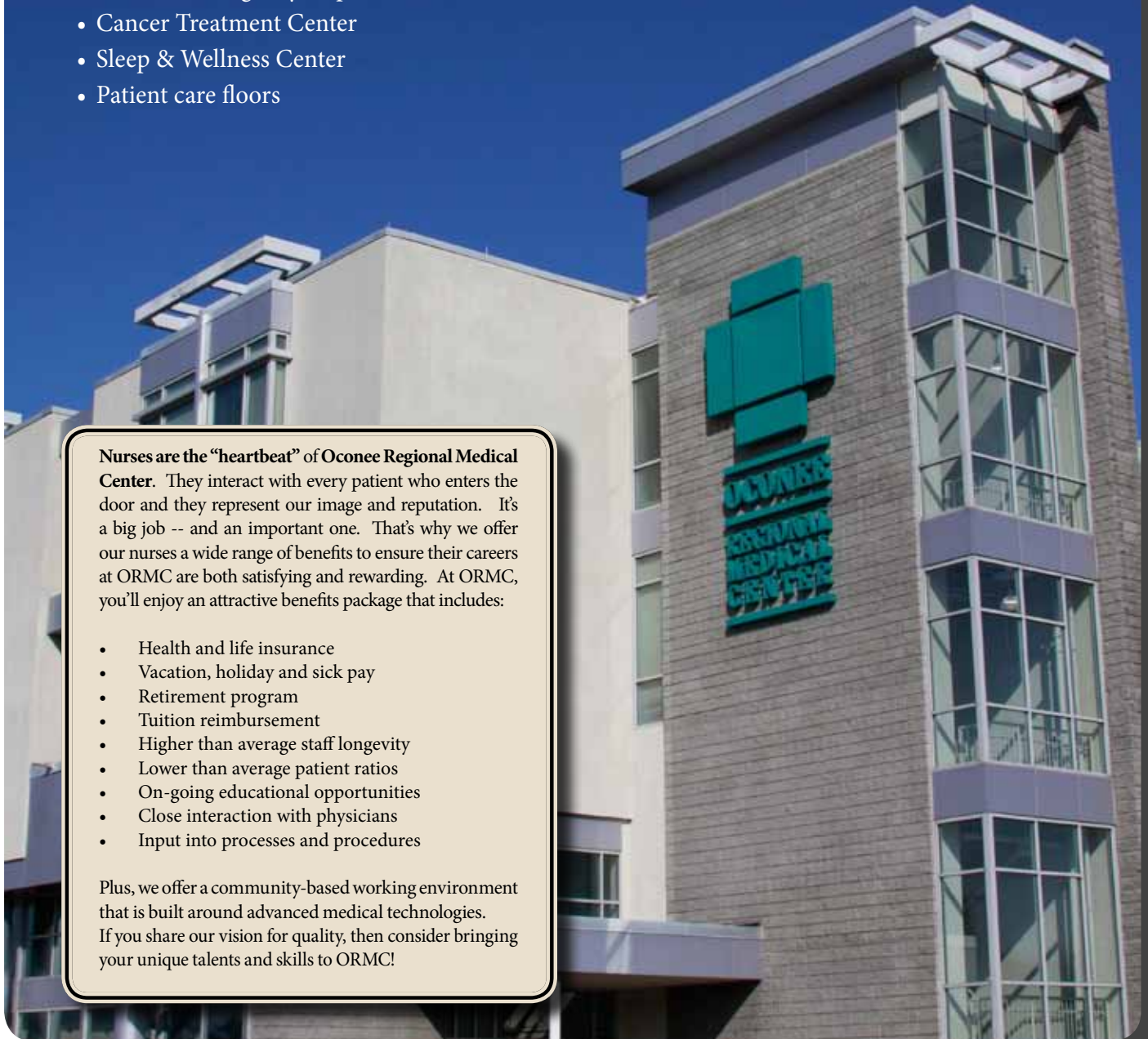
At ORMC, you will find advanced medicine offered in a wide-range of services, including:
